

Third Informational Letter

Dear colleagues,

We open registration for the 11th International Meeting on Cholinesterases, **June 4-9, 2012**, Kazan, Russia.

Participants are welcome to register via [online registration system](#). Registration will be opened until **1 March 2012**. To register you will need to click "Start the registration" button and fill in registration form. After registration the system will send you an e-mail that will contain an activation link along with your login and password. You will need to activate your personal account by clicking on the activation link in the e-mail. Within your account you will be able to pay registration fees, submit an abstract, book and pay accommodation and excursions, and submit visa request.

Abstract Submission

Abstracts should be submitted either via account in on-line registration system or by e-mail abstracts@11che.ru as an attached file until **31 January 2012**. Doc, docx, rtf file formats are accepted.

Please follow the our guidelines for abstract typing:

- Title in capital, bold
- Name(s) of author(s) (presenting author underlined; first name(s) spelled out in full)
- Affiliation(s) (italic)
- Text (1 page maximum for 12 pt font, 1.5 linespacing)
- Please try to avoid tables or figures within the text and reduce number of references as possible.
- Please name your MS Word file as follows:
Last Name_First Name Initial-Session No.doc
(Example: *Smith_J-Session1.doc* or *Smith_J-3D-Session.doc*)

You may use the file provided at the web-site as a template.

In the letter please indicate the Session of interest and desired type of presentation (poster or oral communication). The number of short oral presentations (10 min) will be limited. Therefore, the organizers may suggest that the author prepare a poster presentation instead of a short oral presentation.

Receipt of the abstract will be confirmed, submitted if you didn't receive confirmation, please inform us abstracts@11che.ru. Authors will be informed about the acceptance of the abstract after the deadline of submission.

Visa support

The organizing committee will assist all participants in obtaining Russian visas. We will issue official invitations and offer instructions depending on citizenship to all registered participants. Most foreign participants of The 11th Meeting on Cholinesterases should obtain an entry visa to The Russian Federation. The Meeting Service Agent «CTO GROUP» Ltd will provide participants with the documents necessary for Russian Tourist Visa application. The tourist visa will be issued for the duration of the Meeting. The deadline for all visa requests is May 10, 2012. «CTO GROUP» Ltd has a reference number in the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and has the right to provide participants with Russian Tourist Visa support documents. Supporting documents will be made based on your personal information submitted during the on-line registration process. In order to obtain a Russian Tourist Visa please contact the nearest Russian Consulate or Embassy in your home country for further information.

The Meeting Secretariat will send the visa support documents to participant only after receiving the Registration and Accommodation fees. Please be advised that in order to obtain a visa, your passport must be valid for at least 6 months after the end of your visit to the Russian Federation, i.e. mid December 2012.

Travel

Kazan is the capital of the Russian Republic of Tatarstan. Kazan International airport is located 10 km from Grand Hotel, transfer between hotel and airport will be arranged. There are direct flights to Kazan from Frankfurt and Tel-Aviv, Istanbul and Prague; also Kazan can be reached via Moscow by air (1.5 hour) or train (12-13 hours, including night train with sleeping accommodation).

Trains and flights schedules are changed seasonally, when information about summer 2012 timetable is available we will advise on most convenient flights and connections to Kazan from major European and US airports.

Social program

Kazan has 1000 year history, rich with cultural and historical monuments, and the Kazan Kremlin is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Kazan has one of the oldest Russian universities and branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences. For the Millennium Celebration the city was vastly renewed and modernized.

For all participants of the Meeting we will arrange bus tour around Kazan (included in registration fees).

We are planning to organize several tours during the meeting for accompanying persons to major sights near Kazan (monasteries etc.). They will help to know better Russian history, culture and architecture; you will see signs of 500-year intercourse of Russian and Tatar cultures.

Also we are planning to suggest pre- and post- tours.
